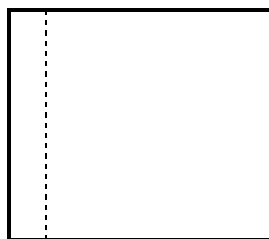

## What you can't include on your letter if you are sending it from outside of Western Australia

Southwest Western Australia is a World Biodiversity Hotspot and Australia has strict quarantine standards to stop pests and diseases entering that might damage unique animals, plants and ecosystems. Normal artistic materials are mostly OK but **do not include**: bark, sticks and leaves, seeds, dried fruit and flowers, honey, beeswax, mushrooms, animal material including raw untreated leather, soil or uncleaned sand.
